



GUATEMALA LEGACY TRIP SCHEDULE

Dear Future Ministry Partner,

We are so excited to have you on our upcoming Legacy Trip! The Legacy Trip is designed to be a scouting trip for you to get to know our ministry and to see how Casas can be a great fit for you to leave a legacy for the kingdom in the lives of the group you bring, the foreign pastors and churches in Guatemala, and most of all, the families and communities who desperately need a miracle.

We have designed the following schedule to make the most of your time when you are with us and we are confident that you will walk away excited by what God is doing. Enjoy your trip!

Sunday

You will be picked up from the airport and will meet the Casas staff members you will be working for the week. Once all the participants are together, you will head across the border. We will take you to your accommodation and give you a tour of the facilities. After you've settled in, dinner will be provided for you followed by an introductory meeting that will set your expectations for the week. At this meeting, you will meet the Guatemalan pastor you will be working with.

Monday

After breakfast, you will be taken out to the build site where you will meet the family you are building for. You will get to pray with them to set the tone for the week. After prayer, you will begin your first day of construction. Each work day will be exactly what your group will experience when you bring them on a trip. We wrap up every build day by shaking hands, talking about the progress, and praying with the family and members from the community who participated.

After going back and getting cleaned up, the family will accompany you for dinner. When dinner is over, you will have Q&A time with the family to get to know them better. Lastly, a Casas staff member will close the day out with a devotion.

Tuesday

Another great day of building! When your work is done for the day, you will head back to your accommodations and prepare for a meeting with the pastors that will include dinner. At this meeting, you will get an opportunity to get to know the pastors on our committee, hear their heart for the communities they serve in, and get to ask them questions about how Casas has affected their ministries.

After dinner, a Casas staff member will lead you in devotions and talk with you about what a Casas dedication is and what to expect.

Wednesday

Whatever is left to complete the house will be finished. Finally, the dedication of the home will take place in the afternoon and will last about an hour. This will be your final time at the work site as well as your time with the family. The dedication is a time for you to join the pastor, community, and family in celebrating all God has done over the last few days.

At the end of your work day, you will go out on a community and accommodations tour. You will get to see different areas we work in and the different facilities that are available for your team to stay in. When the tour is over, Casas will give a brief presentation explaining how to effectively navigate our website, how to register your own trip, and what to expect throughout the registration process.

Thursday

After breakfast, you will head out to Antigua for the day. Antigua is an old Spanish city with many amazing places to explore. Lunch is on you while you enjoy Antigua at your own pace. This is your chance to scout out different places you would like to bring your group. You will head back to the accommodations before dinner. Dinner will be followed by one final team meeting to wrap up the week.

Friday

When you are done with breakfast, Casas will bring you to the airport. If your flight is later in the day, Casas will make sure that you are well fed and taken care of.
