



## Legacy Program Details

- Casas por Cristo will offer a \$1,000 credit for every new team that you recruit.
- The \$1,000 credit will be awarded each year that the new team comes to build with Casas por Cristo for up to five years.
- After five years, we will reevaluate the effectiveness of this program and will either cancel or extend it.
- If team A recruits team B, then upon the completion of team B's build, team A will receive a \$1,000 credit. Team A will continue to receive the credit for each year that team B returns to build. If team B then recruits team C, only team B will receive a credit (not team A).
- The \$1,000 credit is not awarded until the new team has completed their build.
- A new team is subject to verification and is defined as a brand new team or one that has not built with Casas por Cristo in the last five years or more.
- To receive the \$1,000 credit, the new team must name you on their registration form or verbally with one of Casas por Cristo's team coordinators. The registration forms asks, "Who referred you to Casas por Cristo?" The new team should list your name in response.
- If you recruit a new team and then move to a new place and schedule a trip as the leader of a different group, the credit will follow you to your new team and will not remain with your old team (since you are the one that did the work of recruiting the new team for us). The credit will follow you and not your team.
- Each \$1,000 credit can be carried over unused for up to four years. After that it will expire.
- The credit will be awarded for each new team's completed trip, not per each new team's completed house project.
- You can transfer your credit(s) to another team's trip.
- If you are an individual from a Team Casas trip that recruits a new team, you can still receive a credit, which can be used for a future build with a group or as an individual.
- Credits can only be applied to your project fees. They cannot be used to cover deposits or fees for meals, transportation, or lodging.
- There is no limit to the number of credits you can earn.
