



## NICARAGUA LEGACY TRIP SCHEDULE

Dear Future Ministry Partner,

We are so excited to have you on our upcoming Legacy Trip! The Legacy Trip is designed to be a scouting trip for you to get to know our ministry and see how Casas can be a great fit for you to leave a legacy for the kingdom in the lives of the group you bring, the foreign pastors and churches in Nicaragua, and most of all, the families and communities who desperately need a miracle.

We have designed the following schedule to make the most of your time when you are with us and we are confident that you will walk away excited by what God is doing. Enjoy your trip!

### **Sunday**

You will be picked up from the airport and you will meet the Casas staff members that will be working with you for the week. We will take you to your lodging and give you a tour of the facilities. After you've settled in, dinner will be provided for you followed by an introductory meeting that will set your expectations for the week. At this meeting, you will meet the Nicaraguan pastor you are working with.

### **Monday**

After breakfast, you will be taken out to the build site where you will meet the family you are building for. You will get to pray with them to set the tone for the week. After prayer, you will begin your first day of construction. Each work day will be exactly what your group will experience when you bring them on a trip. We wrap up every build day by shaking hands, talking about the progress, and praying with the family and members from the community who participated.

After going back and getting cleaned up, the family will accompany you for dinner. When dinner is over, you will have a question and answer time with the family to get to know them better. A Casas staff member will close the day out with a devotion.

### **Tuesday**

Another great day of building! When your work is done for the day, you will head back to your accommodations and prepare for a meeting with the pastors that will include dinner. At this meeting, you will get an opportunity to get to know our pastors committee, hear their heart for their communities and ministry, and ask them questions about how Casas has affected their ministries.

## **Wednesday**

At the end of your work day, you will go out on a community and accommodations tour. You will get to see different areas we work in and different accommodations that are available for your team to stay in. When the tour is over, Casas will give a brief presentation explaining navigating our website, how to register your own trip, and what to expect throughout the registration process.

After dinner, a Casas staff member will lead you in devotions and talk with you about what a Casas dedication is and what to expect.

## **Thursday**

Whatever is left to finish on the house will be finished and you will head back to the accommodations to get cleaned up and relax. The home dedication will be in the afternoon and usually lasts an hour. The dedication will be your final time at the home you just built and your final time with the family for this trip. The dedication is a time for you to join the pastor, community, and family in celebrating all God has done.

After dinner, you will have a brief team meeting to celebrate what God has done and receive information about Friday's recreation day.

## **Friday**

After breakfast, you will drive an hour to [Monty's Beach Lodge](#) in Jiqilillo. Lunch (~\$15 in US dollars) is on you as you enjoy the pool and private beach at your own pace. Rentals are available for additional activities (kayaking, fishing, paddle boarding, etc.). Scout out different activities for your group. You will head back to the accommodations before dinner. Dinner will be followed by one final team meeting to wrap up the week.

## **Saturday**

After packing up and saying goodbye for now, Casas will bring you to the airport. If your flight is later in the day, Casas will make sure that you are well fed and taken care of.
